



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## ROAD CLOSURE AT AVENUE 24 IN TULARE COUNTY

**TULARE COUNTY, CALIF.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces a full road closure at Avenue 24, west of State Route (SR) 43 in Tulare County for work on a high-speed rail underpass. The closure will be in effect until the end of November 2023.

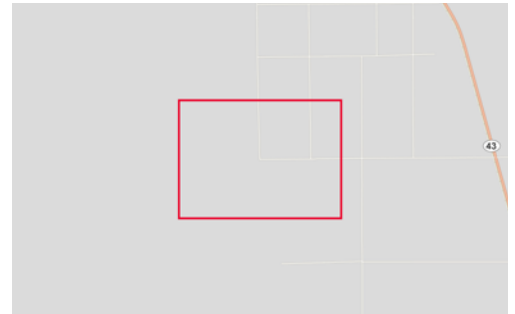
*This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.*

### CLOSURE AND DETOUR INFORMATION:

Full road closure at Avenue 24, west of SR 43 in Tulare County for work on a high-speed rail underpass.

**The closure will be in effect until the end of November 2023.**

**Access to be maintained for business and property owners. Pedestrian access will be restricted.**
