



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## ROAD CLOSURE ALONG AVENUE 120 IN TULARE COUNTY

**TULARE COUNTY, CALIF.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces a road closure along Avenue 120 between State Route (SR) 43 and Road 24 in Tulare County for construction of a high-speed rail overcrossing. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, July 17, 2023 and will continue through December 2025.

*This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.*

### CLOSURE AND DETOUR INFORMATION:

Road closure along Avenue 120 between SR 43 and Road 24 in Tulare County for construction of a high-speed rail overcrossing.

**Work is scheduled to begin Monday, July 17, 2023 and will continue through December 2025.**

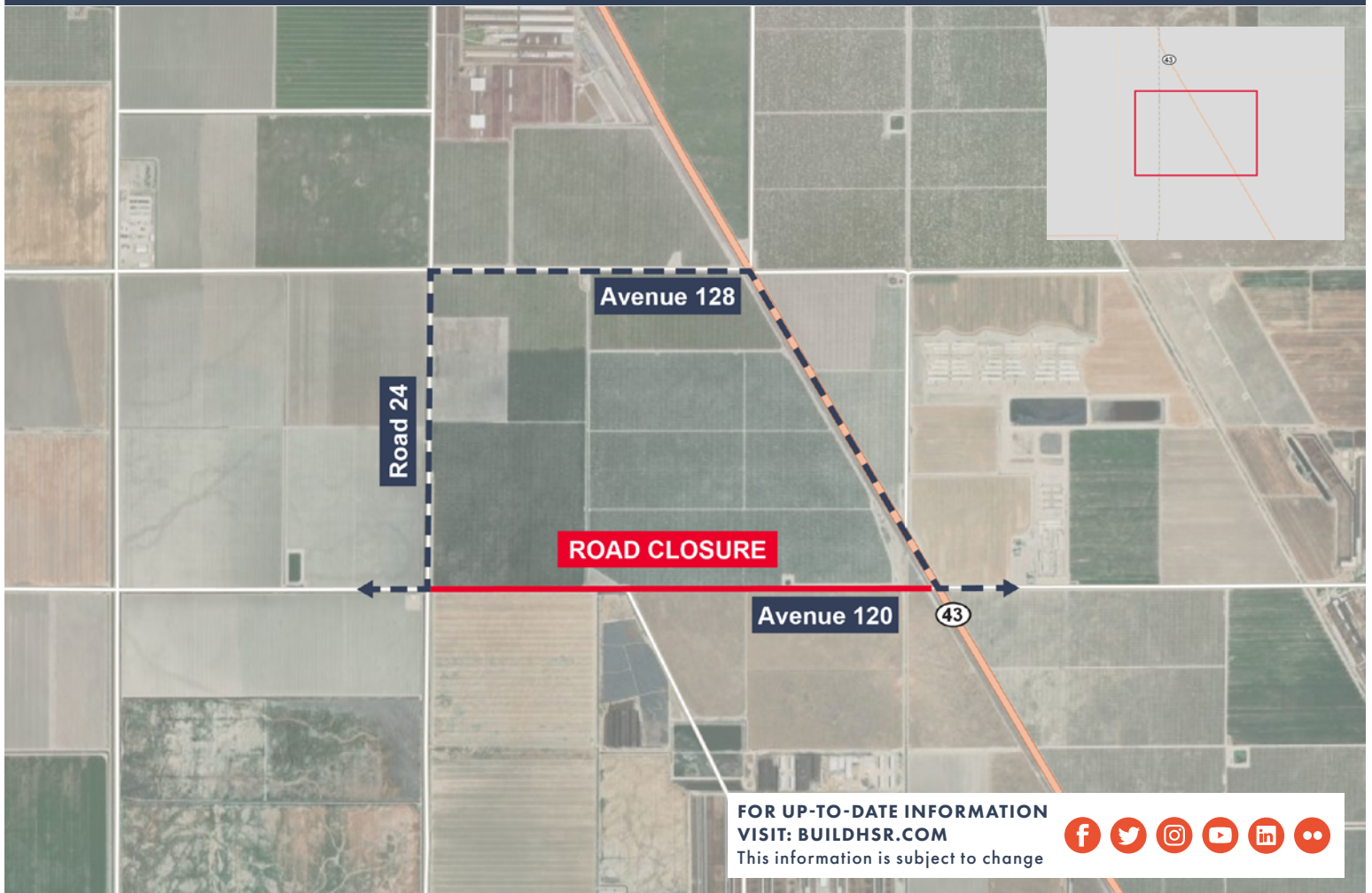
#### **EASTBOUND TRAFFIC:**

- Traffic going eastbound on Avenue 120 will be detoured north on Road 24, east on Avenue 128, south on SR 43 then east on Avenue 120.

#### **WESTBOUND TRAFFIC:**

- Traffic going westbound on Avenue 120 will be detoured north on SR 43, west on Avenue 128, south on Road 24, then west on Avenue 120.

*Drivers should proceed with caution as roadways may be flooded. Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all property and business owners.*
