Shoulder Closures Along State Route 198 In Kings County

Kings County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces shoulder closures along eastbound and westbound State Route (SR) 198, between SR 43 and Seventh Avenue in Kings County for ongoing work at the Hanford Viaduct. Work is scheduled to begin Friday Sept. 8, 2023, and will continue through September 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Shoulder closures along eastbound and westbound SR 198, between SR 43 and Seventh Avenue in Kings County for ongoing work at the Hanford Viaduct.

Work is scheduled to begin Friday, Sept. 8, 2023 and will continue through September 2024.

Signage will be in place.
