



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## Multiple Closures Along Barstow Avenue In Fresno

**Fresno, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along Barstow Avenue and Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for road work. Work is scheduled to start Saturday, Jan. 20 and will continue through Friday, Feb. 9, 2024.

*This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.*

### Closure And Detour Information:

#### Multiple Closures:

- Road closure along Barstow Avenue between San Madele Avenue and Golden State Boulevard;
- Lane closure along Golden State Boulevard, north and south of Barstow Avenue;

- Lane closure along the new Golden State Boulevard.

**Work is scheduled to start Saturday, Jan. 20 and will continue through Friday, Feb. 9, 2024.**

**Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Flaggers will be directing traffic.**
