

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Intermittent Lane Closures Along Cornelia And Mission Avenues In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along Cornelia and Mission avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Jan. 22 and will continue through Friday, Feb. 9, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Intermittent lane closures along Cornelia Avenue, between Golden State Boulevard and Shaw Avenue;
- Intermittent lane closures along Mission Avenue, between State Street and Cornelia Avenue.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Jan. 22 through Friday, Feb. 9, 2024.

Flaggers and signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
