

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Multiple Closures Along Van Ness, Woodward, And Braly Avenues In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along Van Ness, Woodward, and Braly avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Wednesday, Jan. 3 and will continue through Friday, Jan. 12, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Lane closures along Van Ness Avenue, between California and Hamilton avenues;
- Road closure at the intersection of Woodward and Van Ness avenues;
- Road closure at the intersection of Braly and Van Ness avenues;
- Lane closure along Woodward Avenue, north of Van Ness Avenue.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

starting Wednesday, Jan. 3 and will continue through Friday, Jan. 12, 2024.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
