



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## ROAD CLOSURE ALONG ROAD 26 IN MADERA COUNTY

**Madera County, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a road closure along Road 26, between Avenue 18 ½ and Club Drive in Madera County for the construction of a high-speed rail grade separation. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, March 11, 2024 and will continue through December 2025.

*This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.*

### Closure And Detour Information:

Road closure along Road 26, between Avenue 18 ½ and Club Drive in Madera for the construction of a high-speed rail grade separation.

**Work is scheduled to begin Monday, March 11, 2024 and will continue through December 2025.**

#### Northbound Detour

Traffic going north on Road 26 will be detoured east on Avenue 17, north on Road 27, west on Avenue 21, then north on Road 26.

#### Southbound Detour

Traffic going south on Road 26 will be detoured

east on Avenue 21, south on Road 27, and west on Avenue 17, then south on Road 26.

**Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.**
