

## **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

## Multiple Closures Along Thorne, Farris, Harrison, And Safford Avenues In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along Thorne, Farris, Harrison, and Safford avenues, north of Belmont Avenue in Fresno for the construction of a grade separation at Belmont Avenue. Work is scheduled to begin Tuesday, Feb. 27 and will continue through Friday, Sept. 13, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

## **Closure And Detour Information:**

## Multiple Road And Lane Closures:

- Road closure along Thorne Avenue, north of Belmont Avenue;
- Road and sidewalk closure along Farris Avenue, north of Belmont Avenue;
- Road and sidewalk closures along Harrison
- Avenue, north of Belmont Avenue;
- Lane and sidewalk closures along Safford Avenue, north of Belmont Avenue.

Work is scheduled to start Tuesday, Feb. 27 and will continue through Friday, Sept. 13, 2024. Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Pedestrian access will be restricted in some areas. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.



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
