Nighttime Intermittent Lane Closures Along Northbound Weber Avenue And H Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces nighttime intermittent lane closures along northbound Weber Avenue and H Street, between Thorne and Harrison avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will continue through Tuesday, Feb. 20, 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Nighttime intermittent lane closures along northbound Weber Avenue and H Street, between Thorne and Harrison avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.

Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and will continue through Tuesday, Feb. 20, 2024.



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
